

Shanghai Disney Resort Spreads Happiness and Magic Throughout the Community During the Spring Festival

This year, more than 50 Disney VoluntEARS gathered in festive fashion to pack hundreds of gift bags containing Disney gifts and souvenirs. More than 6,000 Disney plush toys were packed by the end of January and distributed to children at 18 children's hospitals in Shanghai, Zhejiang, Jiangsu and Anhui, the Shanghai Children's Home, and to residents of an elderly care home in Huinan Town, Pudong New Area.



The first batch of gift bags were distributed at the Shanghai Children's Medical Center, supported by the Disney VoluntEARS and the appearance of the beloved duo, Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse.



Disney VoluntEARS, together with Judy Hopps from the Walt Disney Animation Studios film Zootopia, embarked on a mission to spread happiness and joy as they visited young patients and their families at Children's Hospital of Zhejiang University School of Medicine in Hangzhou.
